
- 1. How to download the conneX firmware update.
  - 1.1.1. Copy and paste the below link into your web browser to access the website where you can download V2.24.6b firmware. https://assets.welbilt.com/share/55BE6BD7-FF99-4E0C-901C0B7FBCBF68EE/
  - 1.1.2. When prompted by the browser, select "save as" to save the file to a known location.
  - 1.1.3. Extract / Unzip the downloaded file.

- 3. How to put the oven update files on a USB key
  - 3.1.1 Place the extracted file onto a USB key (Do not edit any folders or file names, or locations)
  - 3.1.2 The files on the USB key should replicate the below images.


- 4. How to update the oven
- 4.1.1. Insert the USB key into the oven USB slot located on the front of the oven, behind the air filter cover.
- 4.1.2. Press and hold the power button located top left of the screen for >5 seconds.



4.1.3. The oven will go through a reboot process.




4.1.4. Boot-up initialising screen.



- 4.1.5. When the reboot has completed, the standby screen will display.
- 4.1.6. Press the power button to start the oven.




4.1.7. Select the settings / cogs icon



- 4.1.8. Enter the settings MANAGER password.
- 4.1.9. Then select the green tick.



4.1.10. Select updates from the list



4.1.11. Select "Update IO Firmware"



- 4.1.12. The IO update file name will be displayed.
- 4.1.13. To start the IO update, select the green tick



4.1.14. The IO update will begin. This can take up to 10 minutes.



4.1.15. The IO update finishes by reboot the IO board.



- 4.1.16. After the IO update has completed, the touch screen will display the updates page.
- 4.1.17. Note the IO version has updated the 000.008.084.



4.1.18. Select Update UI firmware



- 4.1.19. The UI will display a preview of the firmware version.
- 4.1.20. Select the green tick to start the update.




4.1.21. UI update progress status.




4.1.22. The UI update will take around 10 minutes to complete.



4.1.23. Once the UI update has completed, the UI will reboot.




4.1.24. Boot-up initialising screen.




4.1.25. Select the power button to switch the oven on.



4.1.26. The UI will automatically start a memory transfer, this can take up to 10 minutes.




4.1.27. The UI will automatically reboot and go through the boot up sequence.

4.1.29. Initialising screen




4.1.30. Select the power button to turn the oven on.
